- 4. How many years and closed/historical claims, will need to be converted to the new TPA's claims system?
 - a. The City has claims data back to 1976.
- 5. How many first party subrogation recovery claims were there in 2018?
 - a. Less than 100 subrogation recovery claims in 2018.
- 6. In 2018, what was the frequency of Emergency Field Investigation occurrences?
 - a. The City experiences approximately 12 Emergency Field Investigation occurrence per year.
- 7. Who is your excess carrier?
